Supply List

Fabric Requirements

****Please wash and press your fabric.****

- 5/8 yard of background fabric—cut to an 18" square
- 1/4 yard ~ Flowers
- 1/8 yard ~ Light Green Leaves
- 1/8 yard ~ Dark Green Leaves
- 1/8 yard ~ Flower centers & Large Heart
- 1/8 yard ~ Small Flower Centers & Small Heart



TURNED EDGE APPLIQUE

- *Heavy* Spray Starch - aerosol
- Roxanne Glue Baste
- Small iron (travel or craft) and small ironing surface.
- Paper scissors
- Fabric scissors
- Small paint brush (child size)

Machine

- 100% cotton thread to match appliqué fabric (not background fabric)
- Size 75 machine quilting needle
- Sewing machine with a blind hem stitch and open toe foot.

Hand

- 100% cotton thread to match appliqué fabric (not background fabric)
- Hand needles - size 9 sharps
- Bee's wax or thread conditioner

As you can see, you have the choice of sewing your appliqué by hand or machine. Both methods have turned edges. You may try both methods if you choose.

The block we are making is from the pattern *Going Home* by Humble Bee Quilt Works. If you choose to make the entire quilt, please refer to the yardage on the back of the pattern.
